4. Parade entrants must be on time for line-up, 8-9:45 a.m. **NO EARLY ARRIVALS!!!**
5. Any violation of the parade rules will result in removal from the parade.
6. All motorized vehicles must be driven by a licensed participant.
7. We reserve the right to refuse participation to any group or individual.

REMEMBER, THE ENTRY DEADLINE IS JUNE 19, 2009.

Any entries received after that date cannot be placed in the parade line-up and will be inserted at the end of the parade if space allows.
